The Hatteras 65 Convertible is a dramatic statement of what a big fishing yacht should be: beautifully proportioned with a flair for the dramatic *and* the ideal combination of superb fishability and extraordinary livability. It looks powerful — and delivers on its potential with performance.

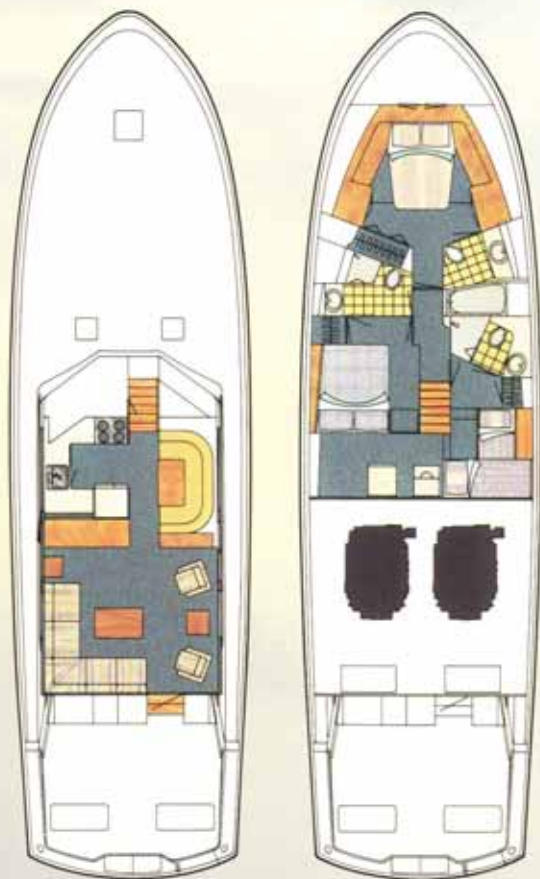
If you've been considering a custom yacht as the only possible way to achieve what you need — but have been reluctant to give up the proven systems of a boat like a Hatteras — it's time to start considering all over again.

And if you're a boat owner who wants quality as only Hatteras can deliver . . . an interior as only Hatteras can provide it . . . there's nothing else *to* consider.

This new "Maxi" sportfisherman features a Hatteras Hargrave modified vee hull, with a sharp entry and a deep keel for smooth tracking.

The rakish bow leads aft to a step-down sheer and ultra-large cockpit. The sleek look continues in both the standard open bridge and the optional enclosed version — in Hatteras' unique integrated design.

The 65 also features a full-length double chine configuration that reduces wetted surface for better performance and provides extra beam for maximized accommodation space inside. Its hull is designed to provide balanced performance in a variety of conditions, everything from trolling to running at top speed.

For your peace of mind offshore, the master boat builders at Hatteras have also incorporated a rugged stringer system, cored hullsides and composite, vacuum-bagged bulkheads and decks. Here's a foundation designed to be both strong and lightweight.

The business end of the Hatteras 65 Convertible is the cockpit. It's *all* business. The result of extensive research by the Hatteras team to make sure the big-game fisherman gets everything he deserves, the all-fiberglass cockpit is 13 feet long and 175 square feet! It has a 38" transom door and gate, 240 and 120 volt shoreline connections, seawater washdown and an access door to the stand-up engine room. And because Hatteras knows what a hunter needs, a



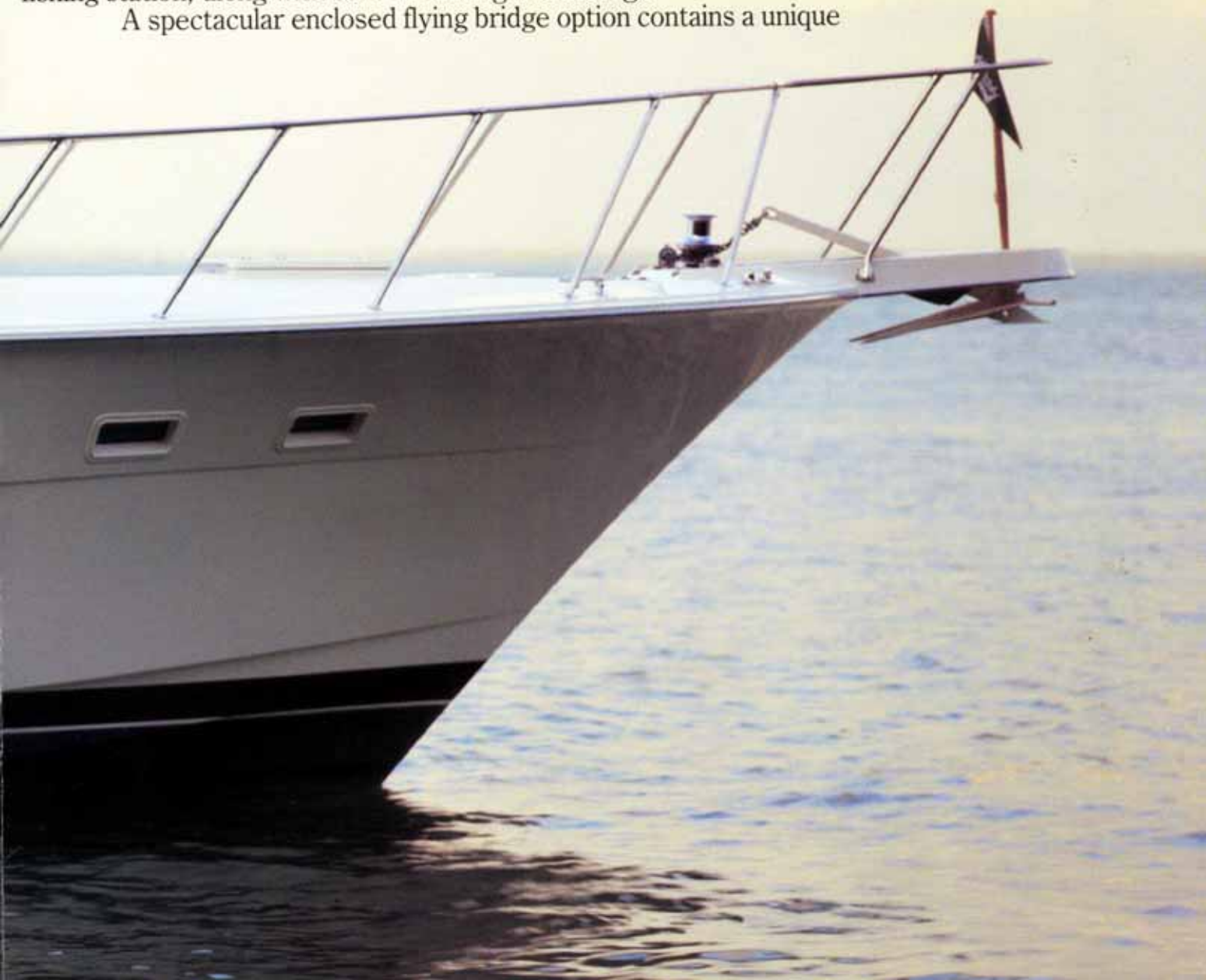
transom fish storage compartment has been added, cleverly molded-in for working your next fast and furious school of dolphin. There's also a bait make-up station and a live bait well with a seawater pump. Along with a twin-compartment stainless steel refrigerator/freezer and additional fish boxes in the cockpit sole (one of which can be refrigerated).

The result is the finest working cockpit you've ever seen.

One more example of the attention to detail is the fiberglass console unit to starboard. It contains a unique sliding rack for artificial lures, so they hang neatly instead of becoming a tangled mess of lines and hooks. Here also is room for optional cockpit controls.

The flying bridge is another example of the kind of design that has made expert fisherman choose Hatteras for over a quarter of a century. It features both a forward cruising helm station and an aft fishing station, along with built-in seating and storage.

A spectacular enclosed flying bridge option contains a unique

helm and console area with instantly visible gauges, and lots of space for electronics. There are three comfortable seating areas: twin helm seats, a raised lounge, and an additional lounge with a seat that lifts up for rod storage. And it's all heated and air conditioned to protect you from the elements.



What would you expect in a Hatteras 65C? That's only the beginning.

Now move inside, and see just how much Hatteras' ingenuity has done with the large 18-foot beam. The accommodations are more than accommodating — they're, very simply, everything you'd want . . . and more than you thought you could ask for.

The main salon features a large aft window to add to the feeling of spaciousness. Distinctly-styled windows are port and starboard to watch your world go by.

The entertainment center (tournament champions really can use some diversion now and then) is forward, and includes the wet bar with icemaker, stereo with cassette, and standard color T.V. with VCR. Telephone and cable T.V. inlets are also included.

Some of the best entertaining, of course, happens around the dinner table. The clean look of light formicas and parquet flooring highlight the galley and U-shaped dinette area. And the galley can only be described in the same terms as the rest of the Hatteras 65 Convertible: exceptional.

The parquet floors and the light laminates of the Galley are as pleasing to look at as the sensible plan is to work with.

The Master Stateroom features a queen-size bed in a setting made especially comfortable by the wood-working craftsmanship of the hands at Hatteras.

A microwave-convection oven, a new four-burner 240-volt cooktop, dishwasher and loads of counter and storage space are included — leave it to Hatteras to do it right.

Located to port, with access from the crew quarters or by liftable steps in the companionway, is a utility room, with stand-up freezer and washer/dryer, as well as the freshwater pump and the air conditioning compressors.

If Hatteras had stopped right here, we have a hunch you would have been thoroughly pleased. But that, happily, isn't in the cards. The staterooms, too, offer comfort and dimensions beyond expectation.

The forward master stateroom features a queen-size bed

fore and aft; a large cedar-lined closet to port; and plenty of dresser storage. Relax in the privacy of your own personal space, and contemplate just how good the good life is.

The private master head is also everything a maxi-sport-fisherman should offer. It features a smart, simulated marble countertop, special new vinyl flooring, and a tub/shower combination with whirlpool jets.

And when your guests retire to their port stateroom, they'll immediately learn that Hatteras designers (and you) are just as thoughtful of them. A unique bed arrangement quickly converts from queen to twins: a special track and roller

system allows for a choice of both arrangements. And like all the heads on the 65, the large, adjoining guest head is air conditioned.

Now what about the crew, you say? We say they should have a private stateroom, with easy access from the salon, to minimize disturbance to the owner or guest. Here, as well, Hatteras proportions provide the room that's needed for long fishing trips and extended cruises. Criss-crossed bunks are just a few steps down from the head and stall shower.

Put it all together with the power options that fit your needs, and you really have something.

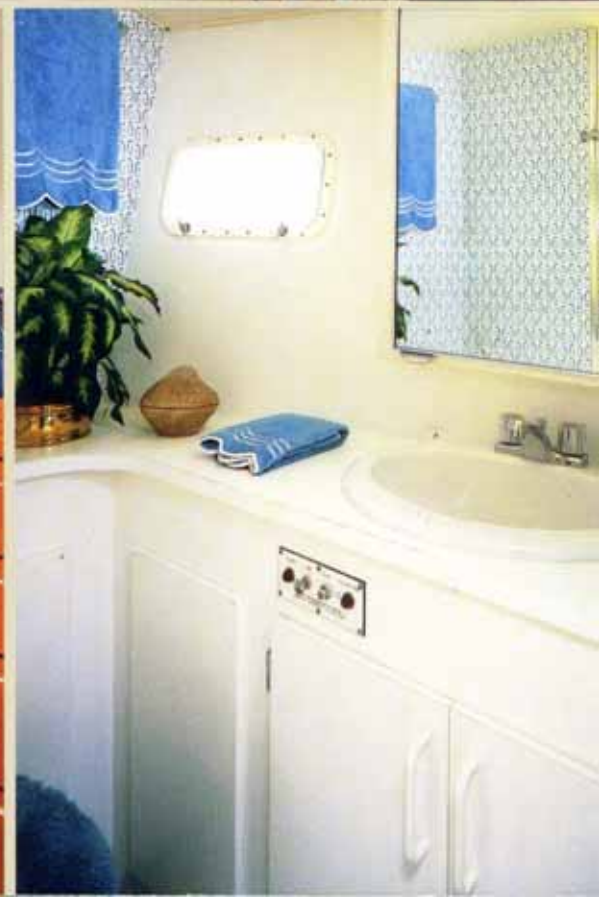
You have one of the biggest fishing boats on the water — all fiberglass and skillfully engineered — backed by the Hatteras team world-wide.
